


Does your paediatric patient have any of the injuries below?

All Brain and Skull Injuries



Thoracic injuries:
including inhalation injury,
asphyxia with brain injury

Vessel injury:
cranial, facial, neck,
thoracic, abdominal,
major disruption to
any other vessel

Pelvic injuries

Lower limb:
open fractures

Spinal injury:
cord, fractures,
dislocation, nerve root

Abdominal injury:
spleen, liver, kidney,
pancreas

Hand:
amputation, total crush

Foot:
amputation,
total foot crush injury

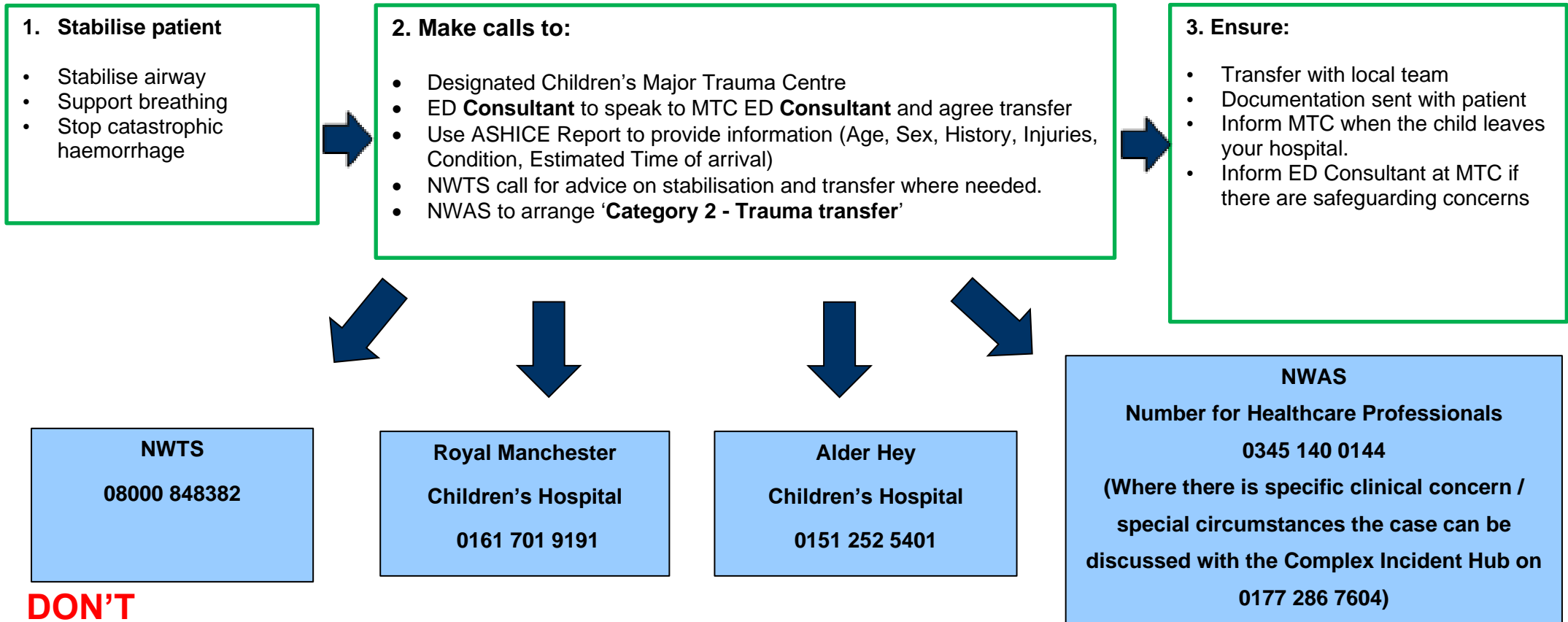

DO



DON'T

- Delay Transfer.
- Contact individual specialist/check bed availability (this will be done by the ED consultant at the MTC).
- Perform unnecessary procedures.
- Perform CT unless advised by MTC.
